## **Pengaruh Discharge Planning terhadap Kepatuhan Perawatan Pasien TB Setelah Dirawat di R. Paru Laki RSUD Dr. Soetomo Surabaya**

**Abstrak :**

*SKRIPSI ABSTRACT THE EFFECT OF DISCHARGE PLANNING TO THE COMPLIANCE OF TREATMENT AT TB PATIENT AFTER TREATMENT IN MAN LUNG WARD, DR.SOETOMO HOSPITAL, SURABAYA A Quasy-Experimental Study By : Rizka Azhari Discharge planning is a learning process of patients hospitalized in the hospital. Discharge planning implemented and simply given as more information. The objective of this study was to identify the effect of discharge planning to the compliance of treatments at TB patient after treatment in man lung ward, Dr.Soetomo hospital, Surabaya. This study used quasy-experimental design. The population comprised 12 respondent, consist of 6 respondents as treatment group, and the others 6 respondents as control group, recruited using purposive sampling. Data were controlled using questionnaire, comprising demographic data, knowledge, attitude and practice. Data were analyzed using Wilcoxon Signed Rank Test and Mann Whitney U Test with significance level of  $p \leq 0.05$ . The result of this experiment showed that the effect of discharge planning on knowledge which is  $p = 0,025$  in treatment group and  $p = 0,046$  in control group. Attitude the value is  $p = 0,025$  in treatment group and  $p = 0,046$  in control group, whereas the value of practice is  $p = 0,027$ . This meant, there is a significant effect of discharge planning to increase of knowledge, attitude and practice. It can be concluded, that the better knowledge, attitude, and practice, the better compliance of respondent, those meant that discharge planning did have effect to the patient compliance of treatment. Further study should be consider to the effect of discharge planning to the patient safety in patient with pulmonary diseases.
